Green Schools Foundation Grants provide an opportunity for staff to fund projects that will enhance student learning opportunities. **Applications are due by Wednesday, October 19 and grants will be awarded by November 7 in order to utilize materials for this school year. Also, this year is a funding category for a grade-level, department or building grant of up to \$1,500. See details below.**

Characteristics of grants high in approval potential are those that meet the following criteria:

- Emphasize student engagement
- Creative and innovative
- Green community-oriented
- Beyond routine budgeted items
- Promote academic excellence for all students

Procedure for Application

- Complete and sign the application form and obtain administrator's signature.
- Submit to the Office of Learning and Teaching no later than Wednesday, October 19, 2011 at 4:00 P.M.
- Attach support materials to original application.
- **Approved applicants agree to exhibit their projects at the 2012 Green Expo.***

Place a check next to the grant for which you are applying. Note that grants may be partially funded.

Standard Grant (funding will be between \$300 and \$500).

Group Grant for grade-levels, departments or buildings (funding will be up to \$1,500). Groups may apply for this grant to achieve a common instructional goal. Up to two group grants may be awarded per grant cycle.
